Jun. 10, 2009:

State of the art technology and workspace innovations take the new JPMorgan Chase Technology Center at Syracuse University to the next level.

On June 1, approximately 40 employees began conducting business in the newly renovated Lyman Hall building on the Syracuse University campus. This facility will eventually house over one hundred JPMorgan Chase employees who perform similar job functions from different lines of business.

But this work environment is anything but business as usual. These teams are co-located by function to enhance cross-line of business collaboration critical for innovative idea generation and operational efficiencies. Functions to be located at the new technology center include Security Access Administration, Application Development, Engineering, Cyber Intelligence and Risk Management.

### Technology Innovations

The technology innovations in the newly renovated facility are impressive to even the most sophisticated of technologists. They include:

- ▶ 1st implementation of wireless VDI in a JPMorgan Chase facility
- ▶ Wireless phones at desktops and in conference rooms
- ▶ The new single screen/3 camera 1300 Series Cisco TelePresence system
- ▶ Wireless internet access for visitors

### Workspace Innovations

A workspace is more than just furniture. The new workspaces were customized for JPMorgan Chase by observing technology employees in their work environments in New York, Delaware and Columbus. The observations resulted in a highly-collaborative, health-conscious and eco-friendly design that includes:

- ▶ Personal and shared workspace that encourages collaboration and increases team productivity
- ▶ 360° computer monitor arms requiring no mechanical adjustments for instant and effortless movement
- ▶ Height adjustable 'air touch tables' which increase blood flow, decrease lower and upper body discomfort, and increase productivity.
- ▶ Wall height and user adjusted privacy screens
