

JPMorgan Chase hiring 100 for technology center at Syracuse University

JPMorgan Chase today opened the application process for more than 100 jobs at a technology center the bank will open at Syracuse University this fall. The company is hiring candidates with information technology experience at various levels.

"We are looking for qualified candidates to help JPMorgan Chase and Syracuse University build a nationally distinct technology program in Upstate New York," said Frank Bisignano, the bank's chief administrative officer. "This collaboration is creating real jobs and delivering long-term value to JPMorgan Chase, Syracuse University and the broader Syracuse community."

Employees will work on information technology and cyber security, risk analysis and application development for JPMorgan Chase and its lines of business, including Treasury and securities services and asset management.

Some positions will involve managing or assisting with the daily technology operations for the large, global bank serving millions of customers. The company also is seeking people to fill technology support positions. Additionally, employees will conduct research for the bank with Syracuse University faculty in areas such as cyber security and information technology risk. The company did not disclose salaries for the jobs.

The center will open this fall in SU's Lyman Hall, a classroom building the bank is renovating. The bank had considered constructing a new building for the center but decided it would be quicker to put it in an existing one, Chase officials said.

"We are excited that our collaboration with JPMorgan Chase is bringing new jobs and new opportunity to Syracuse and Central New York," said SU Chancellor and President Nancy Cantor. "Most critically, faculty and students from across our campus will have the unique opportunity to work side-by-side with these new employees, putting scholarship into action to solve real-world problems in global financial services technology." The company said it expects to hire even more employees to work at the technology center in the coming years. When it announced plans for the center in June 2007, the company said it could eventually employ hundreds.
