



A+ discount

Aug. 13, 2009:

Employees worldwide can take advantage of a discount for online courses offered by Syracuse University—without participating in the JPMorgan Chase Tuition Assistance Program. The deadline to register is August 30.

Thanks to JPMorgan Chase's ongoing collaboration with **Syracuse University**, you can now take classes at the New York school at a deep discount.

And because Syracuse offers a range of Web-based classes, the discount is open to employees everywhere. **Full degree programs** offered through distance learning are at the graduate level only.

If you're a full- or part-time employee, you can register for graduate and undergraduate classes now through August 30.

Full- or part-time employees are eligible for a 25% discount on all graduate and undergraduate courses. Courses that are part of the **Global Enterprise Technology (GET)** curriculum, which was developed with help from JPMorgan Chase, qualify for a 50% discount. GET courses must be taken at the Syracuse campus and are not offered online.

Open to all

But act fast: You need to register by August 30.

The courses don't have to be job-related to for you to get the discount. And you don't need to participate in the JPMorgan Chase Tuition Assistance Program to take a course and benefit from the discount.

How to enroll

You must enroll through Syracuse's University College to get the discount. To sign up, complete the **JPMorgan Chase Employee Registration Form** and follow the mailing instructions at the top of the form.

You'll also need to send an employment verification letter. You can request a letter by calling +1-212-622-8650 and following the instructions **(be sure to choose the non-salary verification option)**. Have your social security number on hand, as well as a fax number where the letter can be faxed to you.
